Major Groups are the broadest grouping of occupations. They represent very general areas of economic activity and are a convenient means of grouping all occupations falling within these wide fields of work. The occupations in the SKN-NOCS are classified at three levels of aggregation. This is done to suit the needs of various data users: Aggregation Level 1 consists of 24 major group as listed in table 1, Level 2 consists of 14 major groups as listed in table 2 and Level 3 consists of 7 major groups as listed in table 3. The 24 Major groups are used to form the NOCS- Working Groups
